This test is aimed to check communication skills on the subject along with the practical knowledge of the candidate in terms of various Do's and Don'ts in a laboratory related to procedures such as hazards, precautions etc. Note: The candidates need to score atleast 30% (i.e. 9 Marks out
	of 30 Marks) and above to qualify in Stage-II examination.
