
1. ART EXHIBITION

The Creative Arts club organized an Art Exhibition at VLTC Front Porch where various students from MNIT and from other colleges presented their entries.



 Lexion Quest event conducted by The English Press club, held on 4 Feb, 2024 in Blitzschlag'24 (Blitzschalg is one of the largest cultural fests of Rajasthan) unfolded as a thrilling intellectual journey through the art of words and puzzles. The event centered around a challenge crossword competition designed to participants vocabulary, lateral thinking, and problemsolving skills. Lexion Quest sought to provide a platform for students to highlight their linguistic prowess and foster a sense of friendly competition within a collaborative and intellectually stimulating environment.

HOW IT WAS CONDUCTED: -

Round 3: Speed Showdown

In this round, participants were presented with a set of shorter yet challenging crosswords, emphasizing rapid problem-solving under time constraints. The objective was to identify participants who could maintain accuracy while navigating the heightened pressure of a timed competition.

The three-round structure provided a full assessment of participants crossword-solving abilities and ensured a dynamic and engaging experience for participants and spectators.

- The participants, numbering expressed immense satisfaction with the Lexion Quest crossword competition. Many praised the event for its creative and challenging puzzles that tested their vocabulary and ability to think critically under time constraints.
 Participants valued the chance to engage in a friendly competition that entertained and sharpened their cognitive abilities.

- Crossword puzzles provided enhanced my learning.
- Length of time provided for solving the crossword was sufficient.

This event transcended the conventional boundaries of a typical informational event. The initiative aimed to cultivate a deeper understanding of the challenges posed by misinformation in the contemporary landscape. It was a meticulously curated exploration, designed to empower participants with the tools necessary to navigate the complex web of information and disinformation prevalent in today's digital age.
- The event was structured to encapsulate not only the theoretical aspects of misinformation but also practical exercises that challenged participants to apply critical thinking skills in real-time. Seek the Truth was not just an event; it was an immersive experience designed to foster a culture of discernment, intellectual curiosity, and information literacy.

HOW IT WAS CONDUCTED: -

- The "Seek the Truth" event was based on buzzer rounds.
- Participants of the Seek the Truth event will need to download the e-buzzer application to participate.
- In the application, they will have to select the "player" option and connect to the English Press Club host. Once connected, they will see questions on the screen related to news after 16 February 2023, general knowledge, finance, sports, and other news topics.
- To answer a question, they will need to press the buzzer before other teams do. The first team to press the buzzer will get the chance to give their answer and must identify which of the two questions contains true news.
- Each correct answer will earn the team 10 points, while a wrong answer will result in a deduction of 5 points.
 The winners will be determined based on the total score.

- The inclusion of a practical simulation, where
 participants had to identify and fact-check
 misinformation in real-time, proved to be a highlight.
 This hands-on approach provided a tangible application
 of the skills acquired during the event.
- Participants were actively encouraged to collaborate, fostering an environment where diverse perspectives could be explored and debated. The integration of multimedia presentations, infographics, and real-life examples added depth to the educational content, making the event both informative and engaging.
- Three rounds were conducted in this event: -
 - 1. Elimination round.
 - 2. Semi-final round.
 - 3. Final round.

• The diverse group of over 50 participants, representing various academic disciplines, expressed their appreciation for the event's unique approach. Attendees were actively engaged in the interactive components, with many highlighting the value gained in honing their ability to critically evaluate information. 








2.BOOMERANG: Cine Sphere


















4. VINES VIBES:


The Travel and Heritage club organized an event called Charades City at VLTC 107 where various students from MNIT and from other colleges participated.
